- a. Assembly bill 953 passed in 2015 RIPA
- b. As a result, it requires California law enforcement to collect certain data on detentions, searches
- c. The data is sent to the DOJ
- d. Process was rolledut in tiers with largest agencies first
- e. We are in 4th tier
- f. Need to push 2022 data to DOV April 2023
- g. Required to collect 40 data points for each detention/search
- h. Data collection isequired by January 1, 2022 ut CSUCI and all other CSU campuses will begin collecting summer 2021
- i. Getting mobile data computers in patrol units
